What we see now is, that the so-called anti-terror fighters, especially those in the West, are extremely silent in the face of the latest Russian success to help the Syrian troops in regaining Palmyra.

This very clearly shows that obviously the self-declared anti-terror fighters are not really doing what they pretend to do.

So this time when we have witnessed this great success of the Russian troops who have been helping the Syrian government, the troops who have been invited by the legitimate Syrian government, who have now helped to save one of the most famous and one of the most important world's cultural heritages, at the heroic sacrifice of a Russian officer's life, who had directed the artillery fire against Daesh from his forward position. And again this reaps no applause from the western side which is very astonishing to those, who believe in the west's motivation.

And while for those people in the western governments what was happening in Palmyra was completely non-valid, deserving no notice let alone constructive remark, all the world has been trembling about the destructions the Daesh caused to the Syrian cultural heritage, which I suppose was visited by the whole world over the last thousand years. Now it is being saved from destruction and the west is silent, and this fact sheds light on the real western policy we face here.

We know and again by the Russian success against Daesh, how deeply involved Turkey was with IS. They were their main customers of the IS' stolen oil and gas, and we've seen the invoices and license numbers and the kind of trucks that were used to transport the oil from IS controlled locations to Turkey.

Then we see comparatively clear-cut signs that the US were also involved in purportedly training moderate troops to fight against Assad. But in fact what they truly trained was Daesh, it was the IS – this is what they admitted later on. And then again we heard the same story for the second time that left people guessing whom they are training right now...

So these are the secure facts we received from captured documents in Syria and the Iraq.

The true anti-terrorist fighters seem to be Russia, Iran and Hezbollah, all of them being invited by the Syrian government – a very sad record for western citizens who of course hope that their governments are truly active in the fight against terror and who right now are being disappointed – yet again.

Right now with all those Russian successes, what we hear from the western governments is in fact a sign of alarm, and this kind of alarm only makes sense if these governments do not side with the Russian side. One thing I can say: the US has, due to a very bad budget situation, due to the disappointments they had from the performance of the US troops in Iraq, taken care to arm and fund and

logistically support radical militias like in Libya, like in Syria, like elsewhere. And these militias are now to serve the western aims especially supported by the Saudi Arabia and Qatar. So what we have here is a very bigot communication situation, on top of a very malignant military situation and this cries for a reassessment by Western citizens.

One of these reassessments is the recent German proposal for a "New Global European Strategy". That strategy would include all those countries who do not want to be ruled by either Washington aggressive performers, or by Washington-paid and logistically supported militias. So if they do not want that, they need some sort of a defense strategy and this is what we call here - "Full Spectrum Defense" as opposed to the American officially proclaimed "Full Spectrum Dominance" strategy. According to the latter, Washington wants to dominate the globe, whereas the other countries want to defend themselves. So what this majority of countries could do, is, not try to equal the US military might, but unite to form a new type of defensive strategy against the global domination of Washington. They would be able to defend themselves without really triggering a military response by Washington, because each one of them is weaker than the US is right now, but unitedly if they come under attack either by regular troops, or by Washington inspired militia, they would be able to defend themselves...

For NATO members like Germany this could come with string of "back insurance treaties" with Russia and other majority members, a treaty type introduced by former German Empire's chancellor Bismarck's glorious policy.

And mind you, "Full Spectrum Defense" also deals with something known as information war - which is, according to the US definition according to US Joint Chief of Staff's official paper "Joint Vision 2020", also a part of an all-out permanent global military "war against terror", and part of this permanent war against terror are all civilian institutions namely also the so called NGOs - so-called "non-governmental organizations" - and, of course, the media. This unified western war effort is an official and integral part of the valid US "Full Spectrum Dominance" strategy, media and NGOs being incorporated into the "full spectrum". By the way, the above-mentioned "2020" paper explicitly strengthened the role of the media and NGOs - as compared to its fore-runner "Joint Vision 2010" paper.

And so it is the western media's recent effort to focus on Russia, on Russian President Putin and on any activity taken forward by Russia. And of course the Syrian activity by the Russian air force is widely discarded as bad, as backfiring, and Russia is still often being accused of not attacking IS. So it is really interesting to get to know who, if not the Russian effort has made IS/Daesh retreat after so many months of purported US and NATO fighting against them... That would be very interesting, indeed!
